

## **Future 10s Timeline**

As students and families prepare for the move to Grade 10 at Eastern Shore Consolidated School, we wanted to reach out and let you know about the process for registering for courses. We offer specialty programs: French Immersion, Options & Opportunities and Skilled Trades. ESC offers all courses that are required for all post-secondary options.

The staff at ESC and OPA are here to help you with this process. If you have questions for the staff at ESC, please contact the main office at 902-342-4004 ext 0 and they can direct your questions to the appropriate person.

### **Week of February 24th-28th**

Staff from ESC will visit each grade 9 class. Students will learn about the O2 program & how to apply. ESC French Immersion teachers will also come and speak to the feeder school grade nine French Immersion classes about the continuation of the program opportunities at high school level.

### **Feb 24th, Feb 25th and March 4th**

The ESC school counselor will visit each grade 9 class to meet with all of our future 10s to review the courses available to choose from for their first year in high school.

OPA will be coming to ESC on March 4th for this presentation and to see the new school.

Students will receive both a course selection booklet and a course selection sheet after their session to complete at home with their family. There is also a section that allows them to plan out courses for consideration in their grade 11 and grade 12 year.

### **March 18<sup>th</sup> – Future 10's Night**

There will be an opportunity for families to ask questions at an evening meeting held at ESC at 6:30pm. There will be breakout information sessions about O2 and Math after the general information session in the school cafeteria. Potential Storm Date – March 20<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm.

### **Last week of March**

Students will be entering their course selections into PowerSchool. The courses available in September are based on the requests put in the system in March so it is very important that students enter their selections accurately to best support our final schedule. If there are not enough requests for some courses, it is important that alternate selections be chosen by students as well. We encourage any students or families with any questions to reach out to ESC by calling 902-342-4004 extension 0 so that their inquiry can be redirected to the appropriate staff person at ESC or they may bring a question to their school counselor prior to the end of March.
