

Class of 2025 Prom May 30th, 2024 - Doors Open 7:30 pm

The goal of Prom is to provide a safe, drug & alcohol free environment for celebration. Any person (regardless of age or legal entitlements) found in possession of, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be dismissed from the premises immediately without a refund of ticket costs. Parents/Guardians will be called and charges will be laid at the discretion of the RCMP on duty. Students who are in violation of these expectations may be denied participation in the graduation ceremony. While at the school, the RCMP, security personnel and ESC staff/administration are in authority. The Provincial School Code of Conduct will apply for the duration of the event.

<u>Prom Forms - Due May 23rd to Ms. Karsten **These are required for everyone who is attending</u> prom and must be handed in before names are added to the prom list***

- 1. All graduates MUST complete the FORM 1, which is on the second page.
- Any potential graduate who wants to bring a guest who is <u>NOT</u> also in the ESC graduating class of 2025 must complete <u>FORM 2</u> Prom Guest Request Form (this includes current ESC students in grade 10 or 11 and former ESDH students). The potential graduate will be assuming full responsibility for their guest. Please see the <u>FORM 2</u> Prom Guest Request Form for more information in regards to responsibilities and expectations.
- 3. Any potential graduate or guest, who chooses not to stay for the entire prom, must complete the "Leave Prom Early" section of the form

- 4. It is a tradition in the community for many people to come to the school to watch the grads as they come into the prom. For safety and security there will be no opportunity for the public to see the gym decorated.
- 5. There is no parking at the school except for staff, volunteers and grade 12s only attending prom. Only students attending prom will be permitted in the bus loop driveway, no other vehicles are permitted in the bus loop or drop off loop.
- 6. There is no smoking or vaping allowed on school property by anyone!
- 7. To respect the entrance of all participants, we ask that the front entrance be kept clear for students, allowing space for families to take their photos and move aside for subsequent arrivals. We thank you in advance for respecting each participant's big arrival.

Prom Guest Request Form

** Form required for ESC prom guests who are in grades 10 and 11 at ESC and for guests who currently do not attend ESC**

Students requesting a guest to Prom must review the following information with the guest and their parent/guardian. Requested guests must be a current registered High School student or recent graduate. No guests over the age of 21 will be considered.

- 1) All guests must complete an interview with ESC administration, if requested. ESC administration reserves the right to approve or deny guests based on information received from other school officials, the interview process, or other information/interactions about requested guest.
- 2) The graduating student will assume full responsibility for the guest, ensuring the guest is aware of school policies and expectations. Note especially, ESC Prom is a drug and alcohol free environment bound by the Provincial School Code of Conduct- regardless of guest's age and legal entitlements. Graduating students are also expected to leave with their guests if they leave early.
- 3) There are no refunds given should guests cancel prior to prom, not show up, or should guests/student be removed from the Prom due to misconduct as outlined in the Provincial School Code of Conduct.
- 4) Approved guests must be prepared to show valid photo identification at Prom to obtain entry.
