Did you know that your child/children's school has a Student Liaison Career Practitioner? Well, it does. So now you are likely wondering what a Student Liaison is.

The School Liaison Initiative is a partnership between Education and Early Childhood Development, EECD, and Employment Nova Scotia/Labour and Advanced Education, ENS/LAE through Nova Scotia Works Employment Services Centres.

I have been assigned to four schools within Rural HRM with ESDH being one on them. My services may be offered to groups or individuals and may be offered in person as well as through virtual methods. Service options at the grades 7 and 8 levels will primarily support school-wide events. Service options offered at the grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 levels will support school-based events (both small and large), small group workshops (in class or extra-curricular) and individual sessions.

As your child/children's School Liaison I can assist them with the following:

- Explore jobs and careers available now and in the future
- Discover what might interest them
- Find a job or volunteer opportunity that can give them experience
- Learn about job searching, resumes, cover letters, interview skills and career planning
- Access job and career information and planning tools
- Explore transition programs if they are not yet ready for work or more school

I look forward to working with the students/staff of Eastern Shore Consolidated on Wednesdays when I am scheduled at the school in space 100 across from the office. Students can drop by to see me, call or email me to set up an appointment.
